MISDEMEANOR CHECKLIST (KRS 431.078):

MOST MISDEMEANOR CONVICTIONS CAN BE EXPUNGED

QUALIFYING MISDEMEANORS:

Any misdemeanor, violation, or traffic infraction

except one that is

- 1) a sex offense or
- 2) an offense committed against a child;

OTHER CRITERIA:

- 1. You have not been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor in the last five years (note: violations do not count)
- 2. You have no pending felony or misdemeanor charges (note: violations do not count).
- 3. You completed your sentence over 5 years ago (However, if your conviction has been voided and sealed you do not have to meet this requirement).
- 4. Either the offense is not the type subject to enhancement for a second or subsequent offense (for example, DUI) or the time for such an enhancement has passed.
